Division of Benefits and Medical Eligibility (DBME)

DBME provides monthly financial assistance and Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (formerly Food Stamps) assistance to eligible applicants and determines eligibility for medical benefits from the Arizona Health Care Cost Containment System (AHCCCS). The State's Hunger Relief Program is also part of DBME.

Division of Child Support Enforcement (DCSE)

The Division of Child Support Enforcement provides services to anyone who needs child support related help. Services include 1) establishing legal paternity for children born to unwed parents, 2) establishing and/or modifying child support and/or medical support orders, 3) enforcing (child) support and/or medical support orders, and 4) collecting and processing child support payments. In order to provide these services, DCSE will also locate parents, if needed.
