Job Description

Job Purpose:

Lead our Joyful Noiz Children's Choir (youth choir 2nd grade and up) and contribute to the spiritual development of children through high quality and energetic music.

Duties:

- Plan and lead rehearsals with the Joyful Noiz Children's Choir which has historically been held on Wednesday evenings, and may also be Sunday at 10:45am during Sunday School, in preparation for special music (typically once a month).
- Actively recruit new members, providing an atmosphere of musical learning, faith growth, and mutual care.
- Plan and execute a children's musical, or collaborate with other music ensembles in a cantata, or create a new type of worship experience that the children can lead.
- Offer ideas and help to implement creative and quality worship services keeping the theme of the day or season of the year in the forefront.
- Provide music for special services i.e., Lent, Easter, Thanksgiving, Christmas and Ecumenical Services, as requested by the Director of Music.
- Promote the music ministries of the church.

Requirements:
