With the Growing Generosity Appeal, we boldly plant seeds for a new generation of growth in the ministries of the Grand Canyon Synod.

This appeal equips our synod to grow in three key initiatives: financial viability, future ministries, and fervent voices.

\$500,000 Initial Goal Reached

Through the incredible generosity of our synod, we reached our initial goal of \$500,000 in early 2022, nearly two years ahead of schedule.

Our stretch goal for the Growing Generosity Appeal is to raise an additional \$250,000 by 12/31/2023, for a total of \$750,000.

Stretch Goal: \$250,000 by 12/31/2023

Through the GIFTS of INDIVIDUALS and CONGREGATIONS, the Grand Canyon Synod raised more than 500,000 within the first year of our three-year appeal. We are filled with gratitude.

Our Phase 2 goal for the Growing Generosity Appeal is to raise an additional \$250,000 by 12/31/2023. The chart below shows how the initial funds are already being put to use throughout our synod, as well as plans for future funds.

Growing Financial Viability Planting seeds of financial support for pastors and congregations through a 3E Lilly grants and programs

O UR INITIAL \$150,000 FUNDRAISING WAS MATCHED dollar-for-dollar to provide a total of \$300,000 for the Grand Canyon Synod.

The purpose of the grant, National Initiative to Address Economic Challenges Facing Pastoral Leaders, is to build a Ministerial Excellence Fund and to help congregations enhance stewardship. The Lilly 3E grant was made possible because of Lilly Endowment's National Initiative to Address Economic Challenges Facing Pastoral Leaders. The program, titled Educate, Equip, Enact (3E), increases capacity for healthy ministry by alleviating rostered ministers' crippling debt and give tools to congregations to increase generosity and renew focus on mission. In the Grand Canyon Synod, 3E has three components: Stewardship for All Seasons, the Ministerial Excellence Fund for rostered ministers and candidates, and Vital Right-Shaped Ministries.

The Lilly grant allows the Grand Canyon Synod to:

- Assist pastors with their financial literacy and management skills through opportunities to learn more about budgeting, saving, and spending, so they may become more fiscally sound stewardship leaders. Rostered ministers will also be eligible to apply for grants toward medical and school loans, as well as the California Lutheran workshop on Executive Leadership Skills.
- Provide scholarships to congregations to strengthen and enliven a culture of generosity through a professionally led program, Stewardship for all Seasons.
- Provide Holy Innovation Grants to Grand Canyon Synod congregations. The grants are intended to assist congregations to define their values, strengthen their mission, notice their context, and evaluate their ministry and leadership among other defined areas of mission.

Growing Future Ministries Planting seeds for Lutheran Campus Ministry and new and emerging ministries

CAMPUS MINISTRY FUNDING

\$100,000 was raised for Lutheran Campus Ministries in the first year of our appeal. In the stretch goal of our appeal, we will raise an additional \$83,333 for campus ministry funding in our synod.

Among other things, funds are being used for our University of Arizona Campus ministry and to explore and potentially launch a Lutheran Campus Ministry program in the Las Vegas area.

NEW AND EMERGING MINISTRIES

\$150,000 was raised for new and emerging ministries in the first year of our appeal. With your help, we can raise an additional \$83,333 during our stretch goal.

The Grand Canyon Synod is aware that emerging ministries need additional support for a longer period of time than the initial funding sources allowed. Funds raised for emerging ministries will be another resource allowing these ministries to grow and prosper.

New ministry funding will provide grants to those making proposals that offer possibilities for new ministry collaborations between congregations and/or other ministry entities.
