What?

At Urban Servant Corps, we believe that people need each other — and that it is in community that we are able to live a more faithful, simple life that is in service to one another.

Urban Servant Corps is a faith-based, intentional community of full-time volunteers who seek to live simply while serving and accompanying those most in need at non-profit partner agencies in the heart of Denver.

USC positions accompany people experiencing homelessness, offer empowerment opportunities for women, educate pregnant and parenting teens, serve environmentally sustainable organizations and assist in resettling refugees.



How?

HOW DOES THE USC PROGRAM WORK?

- Priority deadline March 1 and applications are accepted on a rolling basis thereafter.
- There is one community house in central Denver where up to 10 volunteers reside, each with a private bedroom and shared communal space.
- Volunteers meet weekly for a Monday community night, monthly for a Friday community day and quarterly retreats. These times are for building community, growing in faith, gaining personal insights, and enjoying the beauty of Colorado!

AS A PARTICIPANT, YOU'LL RECEIVE:

- Direct service experience at a non-profit organization that meets your gifts, skills, interests
- Housing, communal grocery budget, monthly stipend (\$150), health insurance, medical fund for Rx, therapy, co-pays
- \$1000 readjustment allowance at the end of service for travel or moving expenses
- \$2000 (potentially up to \$7000 depending on need) in student loan debt reduction paid directly to your loan company upon the completion of the year
- Professional development, personal growth, exploration of urban life, faith journey engagement, life-skills around budgeting/simplicity, lasting relationships, enjoyment of Denver and mountains!
