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THIS CERTIFICATE OFFERS

A cohort-based, online, trans-continental curriculum which empowers participants to cultivate moral, spiritual, and practical power for leadership in the work of climate justice in communities of faith and in collaboration with others. Topics covered include theology, ethics, and spirituality related to climate justice; climate change knowledge; and social change practices that connect ecological well-being with racial, economic, and gender justice. Six Continuing Education Credits are offered upon completion.

EXPECTATIONS

- 2-4 Hours of weekly Independent work
- 2 hours of monthly virtual cohort meetings
- Participation and collaboration with local initiatives, congregations, and/or groups to ensure context-based practice of concepts learned in class
- Willingness to take on the work of climate justice as a spiritual practice within sphere of influence
- Proficiency in English and access to reliable internet connection
